

# JAA Board Meeting August 3, 2021 @ 7:00 pm

1. Call to Order, Introductions, President's Report/Coach J Report Emily

3. Finance

-Audit Update by Committee

The audit committee was appointed in June. Sara Johnson, Debbie Southall, and Amye Bergman agreed to serve on the committee. Sara will reach out to the committee members to set up the meeting.

-Treasurer's Report/Proposed Budget

Emily and Sara reviewed the proposed budget line items.

Link to the proposed budget.

Highlights include:

- Balance forward is \$50, 195.43
- Moved \$20,000 to the helmet fund in June.
- Revenue streams include spirit wear, membership, Casino Night, and concessions. The test drive has been discontinued by Richmond Ford/Lincoln and Game Day Media went out of business so the sports programs will not be done this year.
- Expenses were adjusted for inflation. New items include:
  - an increase in awards for potential state ring contributions (\$25 per athlete),
  - uniform rotation (field hockey, boys and girls basketball, golf and tennis),
  - decrease in facility rental as gymnastics is the only outside rental needed.
  - concession expenses include deep clean twice a year,
  - hotel/bus expenses reimbursement (1/2 if COVID restrictions still in place)
  - Helmet fund includes the purchase of LAX helmets. Baseball helmets may also be needed
  - Campus branding for windscreens for the exterior of baseball/softball fields and the visitor side of the football field as well as decals for the press boxes. There was discussion about this line item.
  - A final vote was tabled until September's meeting so more clarification could be made about the campus branding.
- Liability insurance bill will be paid this month.
- 4. Concessions

## Cheryl

- Cheryl met with Christy on August 2 to go through the procedures and purchases needed for the concession stand.
- A mess was left in the concession stand after the faculty cookout. Red Coats will do one of two budgeted cleanings before the first football game on August 24.
- Need to bleach the white freezer. Emily will ask if Red Coats can do it.
- The fryer stored in the shed needs to be powerwashed to start the season.
- Purchases will be itemized on Square this year. Example, If a hot dog is sold, then it will be entered on Square as a hot dog.
- Emily will purchase another tap reader for the concession stand. The JAA owns two already one for concession and one for spirit wear.
- The drink cooler for soda was broken into at the end of the school year. The handle is still broken.
- Marcia will have varsity parents staff the concession stand for the August 24 JV game.
- During varsity games, there will be two shifts. The shift change will occur around half time. Both windows will be open during varsity games.

# 5. Membership

Kris

- Kris will contact Amye about updating the website. The homeroom will be added to the jotform on the website.
- JAG Pass color changes each year. This year's color will be teal. This will help so people will not try to use the same card each year.

  - Another device is needed for the spirit shed so Marcia does not have to leave her phone this year. Wifi is hard to reach from the school. Emily may donate her old ipad to use for the spirit shed.
  - Whalehook order will be placed by the end of the week. Another order is through BSN.
  - New decals were ordered for the yard signs (approx \$50). Yard sign flyer will also go in the student packets again this year.
  - With only four games, spirit wear needs to be pushed through the online store.
